Dr. Luka Ilić surađuje s labinskim Narodnim muzejom više od jednog i pol desetljeća. Za


potrebe Memorijalne zbirke Matije Vlačića Ilirika izradio je deplijan-vodič za svakog posjetitelja Zbirke. Od 2006. nadalje jedan je od glavnih organizatora labinskih simpozija posvećenih Iliriku, tako da zahvaljujući svojim poznanstvima pronalazi znanstvenike izlagače iz čitavog svijeta, naravno i sam izlaže, a potom aktivno surađuje u objavi zbornika s tih skupova. Za posljednji simpozij uspio je čak dobiti suorganizaciju prestižnog Instituta za istraživanje europske povijesti iz Mainza, koji je i objavio zbornik tog skupa. Godine 2009. u suradnji s labinskim muzejom realizirao je vrlo uspješne web stranice o Iliriku, koje su ranije bile dostupne na adresi www.flacius.net, a danas na www.flacius.info. Istovremeno je za Zbirku pripremio info-punkt s istovjetnim sadržajem navedenih mrežnih stranica.

U sklopu pripreme 500. obljetnice rođenja Ilirika Ilić je bio jedan od glavnih stručnih suradnika prilikom snimanja dokumentarnog filma HRT Zagreb posvećenog upravo Flaciusu, koji je u javnosti vrlo pozitivno ocijenjen. Vezano za tu značajnu obljetnicu Ilić je pokrenuo inicijativu da se u Wittenbergu postavi spomen ploča na kući u kojoj je živio Flacius, a dogovorio je organizaciju stručnih znanstvenih skupova u Beču i Regensburgu.

Dr. Ilić svojim javnim i stručnim radom ne propušta priliku govoriti i širiti spoznaju o velikom Labinjanu Iliriku /navodim primjerice, samo znameniti sajam knjiga u Frankfurtu na Majni/, a time i o Labinu za koji je posebno vezan, tako da dovodi organizirane skupine njemačkih turista kako bi im prikazao Flaciusov rodni grad.

Držim stoga da dr. Ilić u potpunosti zaslužuje predloženu nagradu.

Životopis

Dr. sc. Luka Ilić, teolog i povjesničar reformacije, rođen je 1969. godine u Karlovcu. Protestantsku teologiju i povijest studirao je u inozemstvu. Diplomirao je na Protestantskom teološkom fakultetu u Bruxellesu, magistrirao na Vrije Universiteit u Amsterdamu, a doktorirao crkvenu povijest na Evangeličkom (luteranskom) fakultetu u Philadelphiji (Sjedinjene Američke Države). Naslov doktorskog rada glasi: *Teolog grijeha i milosti. Proces radikalizacije u teologiji Matije Vlačića Ilirika*. Prerađenu disertaciju objavio je kod nakladnika Vandenhoeck & Ruprecht u Göttingenu. Radio je kao profesor na Visokom evanđeoskom teološkom učilištu u Osijeku i kao znanstveni suradnik na Leibnizovom institutu za europsku povijest u Mainzu u razdoblju od 2010. do 2014. Kao svećenik radio je u Zemunu, Haddon Heights, New Jersey, nakratko i u Rijeci i Ravensburgu. Trenutno živi i radi kao župnik evangeličko-luteranske crkve u Balzheimu na rijeci Iller. Objavio je pedesetak stručnih i enciklopedijskih radova i izlagao na mnogim znanstvenim skupovima u Hrvatskoj (Dani Frane Petrića na Cresu, Marulićevi dani u Splitu...) i inozemstvu. Suraduje u organiziranju simpozija o Vlačiću u Labinu od 2006. godine, i priredio je četvrti zbornik s labinskog simpozija o Vlačiću održanim u rujnu 2015. Član je uredništva tri znanstvena časopisa, *Reformation & Renaissance Review: Journal of the Society for Reformation Studies*, *Stati inu obstatu: revija za vprašanja protestantizma* (Ljubljana), *CRIS: časopis povijesnog društva Križevci te redoviti* je suradnik bibliografije o Lutheru za časopis *Lutherjahrbuch*. Bio je stručni suradnik za HRT film o Vlačiću koji je sniman povodom 500. obljetnice rođenja. Glavni je autor mrežne stranice www.flacius.info (prije .org i .net) labinskog Narodnog muzeja 2009.g.
